



Gov Chris Christie's 1st Year: A Time for Union Busting

- 1/21/2010 Bans Unions from making certain political contributions
- 2/11/2010 Cancels a pre-approved \$100 million pension payment and cuts \$475 million from education
- 3/22/2010 Signs three public employee benefit reduction bills
- 3/24/2010 Urges wage freeze for teachers
- 3/29/2010 Offers incentives to local governments to freeze teacher salaries
- 4/12/2010 Urges voters to reject school budgets where teachers haven't accepted a wage freeze
- 5/20/2010 Vetoes Millionaire Tax
- 6/26/2010 Signs budget with massive cuts to local government and education - skips \$3 billion required payment for pensions
- 7/14/2010 Announces pursuit of significant reductions in current employee pension and health care for public employees

- Supports privatizing social security



Generic Congressional Ballot




What's at Stake: US House of Representatives

The basic facts:


- Democrats hold 255 seats

- An in-power party has lost 38 seats or more 7
 times in the last century

Why We Need to Fight

Firing for Effect: US Chamber of Commerce Plans to Spend 75 Million during 2010 Election Cycle

- Chamber sees election as their opportunity to repeal reforms and stymie our progressive agenda
- \$36 million more than they spent in 2008
- Going towards issue ads and GOTV



CEOs, Banks, and Corporate Management are fighting our agenda at every step

Ledbetter Fair Pay Equity Act (January 2009)

- Credit Card Reform (February 2010)
- Health Care Reform (March 2010)

• Wall Street Reform (May 2010)

- Opposed by US Chamber of Commerce, calling it a "wind-fall against employers by employees trying to dredge up stale pay claims"
- Opposed by the American Bankers Association; it "changes the entire business model of credit cards."
- US Chamber of Commerce fought against oversight of health insurance companies, arguing, "market-driven health reforms are the best approach to reducing costs."
- Chamber of Commerce President, Tom Donahue called it a "step in the wrong direction and it will put American companies... at a competitive disadvantage."


