## BCTGM *local union*

- Negotiates and enforces your contract.
- Settles your grievances
- Enforces your job protections
- Offers education classes for stewards
- Supports worker-friendly labor and employment legislation
- Holds employers accountable to the contract
- Organizes non-union workers
- Enforces health & safety laws and regulations
- Acts as an active member of the community



## BCTGM *scholarships*

The David B. Durkee Memorial Scholarship Program annually offers five scholarships to members and children of BCTGM members about to enter college/university/vocational school worth \$5,000 each.
